BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB 174 amends NMSA Section 38-5-2 – Exemption from Jury Service, paragraph B by eliminating the need for an affidavit requesting exemption, and simply requires a request for exemption. The exemption according to statute would be permanent.

Several versions of this Bill have been attempted in years past, and the exemption provision of the statute has been amended. This bill simply removes the need for an affidavit. As many of the FIRS previously reported senior population has many challenges, such as not being able to leave the home easily, drive and find a notary for the affidavit.

The law still requires a request be made to the judge or judge's clerk, and leaves discretion squarely with the judge.
