#### **BILL SUMMARY**

### Synopsis:

HB 35 increases the sentence enhancement for the use of a firearm in the commission of a noncapital felony. Increases the sentence enhancement from one year to three years. For a second or subsequent noncapital offense, the sentence can be increased from three years to five years. Language changes also make sure that any or all of the sentence enhancements cannot be suspended or deferred.

The changes also apply to a juvenile who is a youthful offender or serious youthful offender.
